C.O., 6/06.—His Excellency the Governor in Council has been pleased to approve of the following amendment to the Rules and Regulations for the West Australian Police Benefit Fund, framed under the provisions of 30 Victoria, No. 10, and 48 Victoria, No. 18, and dated the 4th day of January, 1898.

Regulation No. 1.—Insert the following paragraph at the end:—

(6.) Fees, mileage, and other expenses received by members of the Police Force in the service of a writ, or execution of a warrant of the Supreme Court.

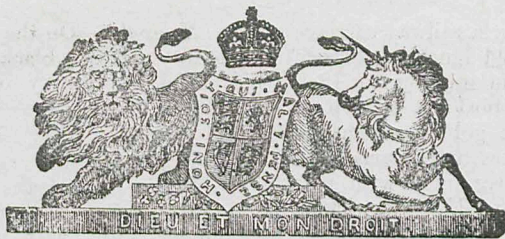

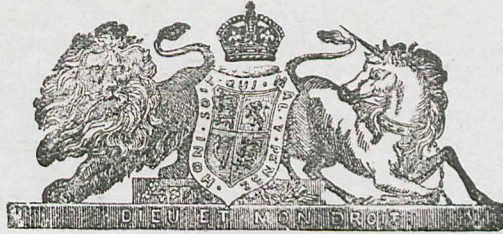

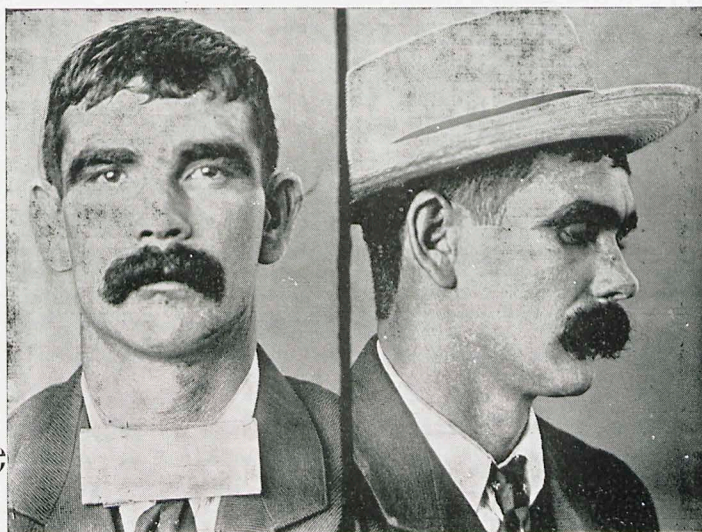
