To print full text articles from these newspapers:

1. Go to the Press Display page required.
2. Find the article required.
3. Scroll across the title. The article will appear blue and a blue pop-up with the title and the opening text displays.
4. Click on the TITLE of the article. A printable page with a printer icon at the top appears.
5. Click on the printer icon.
6. A full text article is printed!
