

Then to scour without perishing the Wool. Our Machinery was especially made for scouring Merino Wool and does not want soap or anything, but yolk from the Wool, except four or five lbs. of soft soap and water hot enough to remove the yolk to commence the day's work—therefore scoured with its own yolk it cannot perish. The heat of the scour should be kept regular and the temperature varied according to the wool to be scoured. Some Lambs', Rams' and dipped Wools require extra soap for scouring. The proof that our machine is the best, can be seen by examining the price of scoured Wool from Dunlop, Boston, Torale, Wingdale and other Stations in New South Wales and Queensland, which realize the highest prices in London and other Markets. The improvements we have made within the last twelve years are about 25 per cent. increase in the output, 20 per cent. in evenness of scouring, 25 per cent. wear and tear in machinery, and what caps all, we have Reduced the Price 25 per cent. We are making three sizes now. No. 1 will turn out 400 lbs. of scoured wool per hour. No. 2, 600 lbs. No. 3, 800 lbs.
