POSTAL INFORMATION.

1.—RATES OF POSTAGE.

PLACES WITHIN WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

Letters—If posted at any office for delivery within the limits of such office :
For every ½oz. or under ... 1d.
Beyond such limits but within the colony, for every ½oz. ... 2d.
Postcards—If posted at any post office for delivery, within the limits of such office ... ½d.
Beyond such limits, but within the colony ... 1d.
Commercial and Printed Papers—For every 2ozs. or under ... 1d.
Packets—For every 2ozs. or under ... 1d.

Books—For every 4ozs. or under (limit 4lbs.) ... 1d.
Newspapers—For each newspaper posted 7 days after publication ... 1d.
If posted within the City, or any Town in the Colony, for delivery within the boundaries of such city or Town ... 1d.
Newspapers must be posted one hour before the closing of the mail by which they are intended to go. ... ½d.
Bulk Parcels of Newspapers of the same issue, posted by a recognised newspaper publisher or newsvendor, per lb., or fraction thereof ... 1d.

Charge to be levied on the aggregate weight of the parcels lodged at any one time. No parcel containing less than four registered newspapers of the same issue will be forwarded at bulk rate.

Registration Fee ... 3d.

(An acknowledgment of receipt of a registered letter or other article from the addressee can be obtained on prepayment of an additional fee of 2½d. at the time of registering.)

Unpaid and insufficiently prepaid letters, packets, and newspapers, will be charged double the deficient postage on delivery

2.—INTERCOLONIAL.

(Australasian Colonies, New Hebrides, Fiji, and British New Guinea.)

Letters—For every ½oz. or under ... 2d.
Postcards—Each ... 1d.
Commercial and Printed Papers—For every 2ozs. or under (limit 4lbs.) ... 1d.
Packets, Patterns, Samples, &c.—For every 2ozs. or under (up to 1lb.) ... 1d.
Packets not exceeding 1lb. may contain articles of merchandise; but packets of mereandise over that weight, unless forwarded per Parcel Post, are chargeable with letter rate of postage.
Books—For every 4ozs. or under (limit 3lbs.) ... 1d.
Newspapers—Each (not exceeding 10ozs.) ... ½d.
Newspapers must be posted one hour before the closing of the mail by which they are intended to go.
Registration Fee ... 3d.

(An acknowledgment of receipt of a registered letter or other article from the addressee can be obtained on prepayment of an additional fee of 2½d. at time of registering.)

Parcels Post—To Victoria, Queensland, New Zealand, and Tasmania, only—
For each parcel of 1lb or under ... 8d.
Each additional lb. or under (up to 11lbs.) ... 6d.

3.—RATES TO THE UNITED KINGDOM

Letters—For every ½oz. or under ... 2½d.
Postcards—Each ... 1½d.
(a) Commercial Papers—not exceeding 4ozs. ... 2½d.
Exceeding 4ozs., but not exceeding 6ozs. ... 3d.
Every additional 2ozs. or under (limit 4lbs.) ... 1d.
(b) Printed Papers—Other than newspapers not exceeding 2ozs. ... 1d.
Every additional 2ozs. or under (limit 4lbs.) ... 1d.

(c) Patterns and Samples—For every 2ozs. or under (limit 1lb.) ... 1d.
Newspapers—Each (not exceeding 4ozs.) ... 1d.
Newspapers must be posted one hour before the closing of the mail by which they are intended to go.
Registration Fee ... 3d.

(An acknowledgment of receipt of a registered letter or other article from the addressee can be obtained on prepayment of an additional fee of 2½d. at time of registering.)

Parcels Post—Wholly by sea—For each parcel of 2lbs. or under ... 1s. 6d.
Each additional lb. or under (up to 11lbs.) ... 9d.
No parcel must exceed 3ft. 6in. in length, or 6ft. in girth and length combined.

4.—RATES TO FOREIGN COUNTRIES AND THEIR COLONIES.

Letters—For every ½oz. or under ... 2½d.
Postcards—Each ... 1½d.
(a) Commercial Papers—Not exceeding 4ozs. ... 2½d.
Exceeding 4ozs., but not exceeding 6ozs. ... 3d.
Every additional 2ozs. or under (limit 4lbs.) ... 1d.
(b) Printed Papers—Other than newspapers—not exceeding 2ozs. ... 1d.
Every additional 2ozs. or under (limit 4lbs.) ... 1d.
(c) Patterns and Samples—For every 2ozs. or under (up to 8ozs., or up to 12ozs. on packet addressed to France and a few other countries) ... 1d.
Newspapers—For each newspaper not exceeding 4ozs. ... 1d.
Every additional 4ozs. or under ... 1d.
Newspapers must be posted one hour before the closing of the mail by which they are intended to go.
Registration Fee ... 3d.
