Albany.—A port and municipality on Princess Royal Harbour. King George's Sound, is the port of call of the mail steamers and the southern terminus of the G. S. Ry., distant 341 miles S. by rail from Perth, 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ by road. Railway fares to Perth, 5s. 1d. and 40s.; return, 8s. 2d. and 60s.; special, 25 per cent. extra. Mail and train service to Perth daily. English and Colonial mails weekly by P. & O. and Orient steamers alternately. The French mail steamers call monthly. Steamers are despatched from London to Albany railway pier every two months by Messrs. Bethell, Gwyn & Co. and Trinder and Anderson & Co. Steamers to and from the Eastern Colonies for Fremantle and Northern ports at frequent intervals; also schooners for Esperance Bay and other places on South coast. Churches, C. V., R.C., Wes., Pres., and S.A. Govt., R.C. and Private Schools. Post, Telegraph, M.O.O. and S.B. Banks: "Union," "National" and "Commercial." Newspaper, *Australian Advertiser*, 1d. thrice weekly.
