A contribution of £2 for every 1,000 sheep, or such other less sum as the governor in executive council may determine & as may be notified in the "Government Gazette," & so in proportion for any greater or smaller number possessed by one owner.
 "Contribution" to be paid on or before 1st April in each year.
 Districts declared clean are not liable to pay any "contribution."
 All penalties inflicted under "The Seab Act, 1891," are paid into the treasury, unless the governor directs one moiety to be paid to the informer or complainant.
