**GENERAL INFORMATION.**  
 The address of the Agent-General for Western Australia is 15 Victorin street, London, S.W.

(a) Free passages are given to a limited number of female domestic servants (apply to the Agent-General)  
 (b) Assisted passages can at present only be granted to farmers, agriculturists & such others as are likely to be useful in country districts, all of whom must be possessed of some small capital. Application must be made to the Agent-General, & the amount required in each case will be decided by him & must be deposited with him. As a rule, a single man will be required to deposit not less than £100, and a married couple not less than £150, & £25 for each child over 12 years of age. The deposit will be repaid at the Treasury to the emigrants immediately after their arrival in the Colony. Each approved adult emigrant will be granted £10 towards his passage money, & a sum not exceeding £5 for every child between 1 & 12 years of age. Assistance will also be given to *bona fide* farm labourers to the extent of £7 10s

Each intending emigrant must undertake to remain in the Colony for at least 12 months from the date of arrival  
 (c) Nominated Passages.—Assisted passages are granted to a limited number of female emigrants upon application to the Secretary, Education Department, Perth, West Australia, by persons residing in the Colony. They must be single women, or widows, not exceeding 35 years of age, without children. They must in all cases be approved by the Agent-General. The nominators or the emigrants must pay £8 5s. which includes ship kit, towards their passage by direct line steamer; fares by mail steamer are higher, viz.: about £10 7s. by the Orient line  
 N.B.—All nominations lapse at the expiration of 12 months from emigrants receiving notice from the Agent-General of their having been nominated
