The Eastern Group of Goldfields are connected with the harbour of Fremantle, from which a Government Railway extends as far as Kalgoorlie. The distance from Fremantle to Southern Cross, via Perth, is 245 miles; from Southern Cross to Coolgardie 130 miles, and from thence 24 miles to Kalgoorlie. At the end of March last, the railway was further extended—a distance of 80 miles—to Menzies. From these centres roads branch out to all the various mining centres.

The Murchison and Yalgoo are connected with the port of Geraldton by Government Railway, the distance being—Geraldton to Yalgoo 138 miles, Yalgoo to Mt. Magnet 77 miles, Mt. Magnet to Cue 47½ miles; from Cue a railway has been surveyed to Nannine, the distance being 40 miles. The port of Geraldton is connected with Perth by railway, a distance of 306 miles.

The East Murchison Field is connected to Cue and Mt. Magnet by well watered roads, a distance of about 210 and 180 miles respectively. The Peak Hill Field is connected with Cue by coach road via Nannine and Abbott's, a distance of 180 miles; other centres on the Murchison Group of Goldfields being connected with the railway line by well watered roads, which is a feature of the Murchison Fields.

The Ashburton Goldfield is connected with the port of Onslow by road, about 180 miles. The Gascoyne Goldfield is connected with the port of Carnarvon by road, which is not, as yet, well watered. The field is also connected with the Murchison Fields, via Peak Hill, by have not been supplied with wells, and travellers have to rely on the water holes in river beds.

The West Pilbarra and Pilbarra Goldfields are connected with the port of Cossack, 12 miles from Roebourne.

The small port of Condon is situated also about 80 miles North from Marble Bar, with which it is connected by road. There is also a road about 100 miles in length to Port Hedland, in the Cambridge Gulf.

The Kimberley Goldfield is connected with the port of Wyndham, in the Cambridge Gulf, which is 200 miles North from Hall's Creek.

The Dundas Goldfield is connected by road with the small port at Esperance Bay, distant about 150 miles South from Norseman Town.

Telegraph Stations have been established on the Kimberley Field at Hall's Creek and Derby; on Pilbarra Goldfields at Marble Bar, Bamboo Creek, Roebourne, Mallina, Toweranna, Nullagine, Pilbarra, Talga Talga, Condon; on the Murchison Fields at Nannine, Cue, Day Dawn, Oudling-Coolgardie, Southern Cross, Kalgoorlie, Kanowna, Kurnalpi, Broad Arrow, Bardoc, Menzies, Dundas, Norseman, Black Flag, Bulong, Kurawa, Kurnalning, Londonderry, Niagara, White Flag, Yerilla, Laverton, Mount Malcolm, Diorite King, and all the ports of the Colony previously mentioned.

The North German Lloyd S. S. Coy's. Mail Steamers call monthly both Inwards and Outwards at Fremantle.

Mail Steamers from Europe and the Eastern Colonies call weekly, both ways, at Albany, and it is anticipated that from 1st March, 1900, the P. & O. Co., will also call at Fremantle.

There is a line of railway from Albany connecting with the Fremantle-Coolgardie line at Northam, a distance of 247 miles, trains running daily. Passenger fares on the Government Railways are 2d. per mile first class and 1½d. second class.
