DISTRICT ROADS BOARDS.

**ROADS.**—The roads of the State, outside of Municipalities, are principally under the charge of District Roads Boards, who have powers under the "Roads Act" similar to those given to Local Government Bodies in the other States. A good number of roads, however, on Goldfields where water supply is a principal factor, are constructed and maintained by Mines Water Supply Dept. of State—are constructed and maintained at considerable cost, owing to their great length and remoteness, by the Public Works Dept. Roads Boards are authorised to levy a general rate on property adopted, or 2d. in the £ on the unimproved capital value. The Roads Boards are also charged with the collection of Carriage Licenses, and Dog tax, and water supplies along roads which are principally constructed by Works Dept. and handed over to Local control. The whole of the Administration of the funds voted by Parliament for roads and bridges, as well as is under the control of the Public Works Dept. Roads Board Clerk: A. E. Sanderson; Auditors: H. J. Ash and G. W. E. Plunkett.
