H.B.M.'s Consuls in all parts of Europe and elsewhere, in their annual reports to the Foreign Office, have repeatedly pointed out the importance to British Manufacturers of their communications with prospective customers being in the language of the country with which they wish to do business.

In quoting prices, Manufacturers and Shippers should base their calculations on the weights and measures prevailing in any particular country, and the prices should be in its currency.

The practice with British Manufacturers of sending out their circulars, price lists, &c., in English should be avoided: our Consuls consider them quite useless in that form, as prices quoted in English money for goods in the weights and measures of this country, are unintelligible to the vast majority of Foreign Buyers.

The Publishers trust that the information given in THE CUSTOMS TARIFFS OF THE WORLD will be of material assistance to Manufacturers and Merchants doing, or seeking to do, an Export Trade, and to increase its usefulness, *Tables of Foreign Moneys, Weights and Measures, with their English equivalents, are given.*
