Nominated Passages.—Those passages are granted by the Colonial Secretary in Perth, Western Australia, upon application from persons residing in the State. Emigrants must in all cases produce certificates of character and health before being approved by the Agent-General in London. The nominators or the emigrants must pay from £2 upwards towards their passages; the Government paying the balance, which includes ship kit. Advanced Passages.—N.B.—All nominations lapse at the expiration of 12 months from emigrants receiving notice from the Agent-General of their having been nominated. The Govt. also advances money to defray passages, from other portions of the Commonwealth, of wives and families of W. A. residents. Application in respect to above must be made to the Immigration Dept. Perth

Australian standard.

On varying dates in the year 1895 the hour-zone system of time was adopted by the Australian States. The following particulars give the time (in relation to Greenwich mean time), which has been fixed upon as standard time in the respective States:—
