IMPORTANT NOTICE, WAR POSTAGE CHARGE

- A War Postage Charge of one halfpenny (1/2d.) is payable on each postal articls, irrespective of weight, except the following:---
- (a) Postal articles of all classes to & from members of the Forces, whether located in Australia or abroad, to which the special reduced rates of postage apply :
- (b) Air Mail articles addressed to places beyond the Commonwealth other than New Zealand, Papua & New Guinea:
- (c) Parcels sent by Parcels Post either within Australia or overseas

Rates of Postage-Defence Forces

Special rates of postage apply to mail matter addressed to members of the Naval, Military or Air Forces on war service. Letters are 1d per oz, mer-chandise (up to 1 lb) 1d per 4 ozs, newspapers 1d per 12 ozs. For other articles & parcels inquire at Post

Air Letter Service

A new means of communication by Air Mail with members of the Forces abroad, civilians in certain countries & Prisoners of War is now available and the appropriate forms may be purchased at Post Offices—the price of each form is 7d, which is the amount of postal charge irrespective of whether the Air Letter is addressed to a mem-ber of the Forces, Civilian or Prisoner
