ANGLICAN CHURCH. WONTHELLA. St Mary the Virgin Church

St Mary the Virgin, Wonthella, is part of the Parish of Bluff Point. The first Anglican service at Wonthella was given by Rev JG Crook on 12 December 1937. The church was built by voluntary labour with the parish. It was dedicated by Right Rev John Frewer on 14 May 1939.
