**GRAND LODGE OF WESTERN AUSTRALIAN FREEMASONS (INC)
LODGE AUSTRALIA NO. 35 WAC**

The Lodge was consecrated on the 6 October 1899 in the Masonic Hall, Hay Street, Perth by the Deputy District Grand Master, V.W. Bro. J.W. Hackett as No. 2801 EC. It transferred its allegiance to the Grand Lodge of WA on the formation of that Constitution in 1900. At this time the lodge is still active (2000).
