Born 13 August 1911 and a graduate from the University of Western Australia 1931 and with honours in 1932. Miss Lukis first worked as a teacher from 1934 to 1940 in Perth, Victoria and England, four years with the Munitions Supply Laboratories for the war years. In 1945 Miss Lukis was appointed State Archivist of the Museum and Art Gallery of WA
