Katharine Susannah Prichard writer and political activist was born on 4 December 1883 at Levuka, Fiji, eldest child of Tom Henry Prichard, newspaper editor, and his wife Edith Isabel, nee Fraser. On 28 January 1919 she married Hugo [Jim] Throssell and she moved from Melbourne to Greenmount, on the Darling Range escarpment outside Perth, her permanent home. Katharine Susannah Prichard died in Perth on October 1969.
