HARRISON, Reginald Court

Reginald Court Harrison was prominent for many years in the commercial and public life of Western Australia. For a period of nearly nine years he was licensee of the Shamrock Hotel, and then licensee of the Criterion Hotel.

During his business career in Perth, he identified himself with a number of amusement enterprises with varying success. Reginald Court Harrison interested himself in public affairs and became most prominently known as organiser and founder of the Perth-Fremantle Road "Busy Bee".

He had a keen interest in sport, was involved in the cause of Buffaloism in Australia and was for some time, President and Treasurer of the Blind Soldiers Association.
