

EGERTON-WARBURTON Family

Born 23.09.1819 in Chester, England, and arriving in Tasmania in 1838 as a soldier on a convict vessel, Ensign Egerton-Warburton sailed as part of a relief detachment for the King George Sound settlement in 1839. Finding life in a free colony preferable to that in penal Tasmania, he planned to settle in the region. In command of the Mt Barker and Kojonup outposts, he was also appointed Assistant Surveyor in 1841. On his marriage to Augusta Spencer in 1842, he bought and leased pastoral land in Mt Barker, pioneering the pastoral industry in the region. When his regiment was ordered to India in 1846, he resigned from the Army, receiving a further 100 acres of land for his years of service; by 1856 he held 30,000 acres, stocked with 1,500 sheep. The new road to the Swan River, together with British steamships using Albany as the only western port of call brought prosperity to the area, as did the 1850 introduction of convict labour. Mr Egerton-Warburton was in charge of the Albany convict depot from 1852-1855. In 1874, a private church built on his property was dedicated by Bishop Hale. He died in 1889, survived by his second wife, Emma and his twelve children.
