

DRAKE-BROCKMAN, Henrietta

Henrietta Drake-Brockman was the only child of English born Martin Edward Jull, Public Servant, and his wife Roberta Henrietta Margaritta (nee Stewart), a medical practitioner from Scotland.

Henrietta was a Foundation Member (1938) of the Fellowship of Australian Writers (WA Branch). In 1967 she was awarded the O.B.E. She died on 8 March 1968, and is buried in Karrakatta Cemetery.
