

## **SUNSET HOSPITAL**

The original Sunset Hospital, previously known as the Old Men's Home, was built overlooking the Swan River at Freshwater Bay in 1904. It replaced the Mount Eliza Depot, which had been used for convicts, the poor and sick since the 1850s. On October 11<sup>th</sup> 1964, Matron Pegrum, together with her staff and seventeen female patients transferred from Knutsford Hospital to Ward 10 at Sunset Hospital.

In 1994 it was announced that the hospital would close, stating unsuitability of the buildings and the cost of maintenance as the reason. A history of the Hospital is shelved in Battye under 362.16WHY, "Sunset Hospital".
