

AUSTRALIAN WOMEN'S ARMY SERVICE ASSOCIATION WESTERN AUSTRALIA (Inc)

On November 10th 1941 the Australian Women's Army Service was established for the purpose of replacing able-bodied men so that they could perform an active part in the defence of Australia. Originally 21 women were enlisted and they were sent for officer training. This small band was the nucleus of what would be a force of over 9000 women within 22 months carrying out important tasks such as clerks, plotters, switchboard operators, orderlies, waitresses, draughtswomen, cooks, motor and ambulance drivers, photographers and typists. The A.W.A.S. was disbanded in 1946 and the Australian Women's Army Service Association Western Australia (Inc) ceased on 7 February 2008.
