

FERRELL, JOHN, 1938-

John Ferrell was commissioned by the Boddington Shire Council to write a local history. The work, which was published as 'Becoming Boddington', celebrates 100 years of local government in the Boddington district. The book spans the period from 1830 to 1992 and covers all aspects of community life from pioneer subsistence to development of the Boddington Gold Mine.

Some of the early settlers mentioned are Batt, Farmer, Fawcett, and Pollard families, and an Aboriginal tracker, Dilvan, who was of great assistance to Sir John Forrest.
