

## **HUTCHINSON, John Nicholas**

John Hutchinson was an ornithologist and a wildlife bird calls recordist. He was the author of the book "Save that Song" and most of the material for this book came from the many letters he wrote, particularly those that were written to his mother.

The recordings contained in ACC 10724AD are digital reproductions that were resourced by the donor. Most of the original audio-tape reels from that collection range have been donated to the West Australian Museum. Some of these recordings contain Indigenous Cultural Intellectual Property (ICIP).
