

## HENTY Family

Papers of James Henty and other members of the Henty family relating to their lands on the Swan River, Western Australia, the voyage out, to transport of goods etc.

Arrived W.A. on "Caroline" with brothers John and Stephen. They were granted 84,413 acres of land, selected in Swan, Leschenault, and Plantagenet districts, all of which were later transferred to other occupiers. Left W.A. for Tasmania, 1832.
