

## NEW NORCIA BENEDICTINE MONASTERY

New Norcia was founded on 1 March 1846 by two Spanish Benedictine Monks, Reverend Father Joseph Serra and Rosendo Salvado from Spain as a Catholic Mission for the benefit of the local Aboriginal population. It was established as Abbey Nullius on 12 March 1867. Rosendo Salvado became Lord Abbot on the same date. The Monks lived a monastic life whilst engaging in activities such as farming and conducting the mission as well as working as parishioners and teachers.

In 1906 Abbot DF Torres explored the north west coast of Australia, searching for a suitable location for an aboriginal mission. He decided upon an area inland along the Drysdale River as a site of the first camp. After further exploration, which was undertaken in 1908, it was considered that the mission should be located near the coast within a small bay, which was named Mission Cove. The mission became known as the Drysdale River Mission. In 1937 the main north west mission centre was moved to its present site at Kalumburu.

Aboriginal education is discussed and examples of their work examined. The superiority of the New Norcia aboriginal cricket team in the city of Perth is referred to. Also Bishop Salvado's action to make New Norcia into a corporation - nominally the Benedictine Community of New Norcia Incorporated. p. 151-171.
