LOCAL GOVERNMENT

For the purposes of the Land Regulations and Geographical divisions the State is divided into five Divisions.
Population: Males, 178,448; Females, 157,195; Total 335,643
South-West Division contains 96,032 square miles, and is the most temperate part of Western Australia. It was the portion of the State first settled.
Eastern Division contains an area of 451,891 square miles and comprises the far interior of the State.
North-West Division contains 219,157 square miles, and is a rich pastoral division.
Kimberley Division contains an area of 134,995 square miles. The Kimberley Goldfields, situated at the watershed of the Fitzroy and the Ord, are within this division.
Eucla Division, contains 78,845 square miles, and contains many miles of splendid pastoral country.
