

BUNBURY CATHEDRAL, ST BONIFACE CATHEDRAL. ANGLICAN CHURCH

The Diocese of West Australia was multiplied in 1904 and the Diocese of Bunbury, Western Australia was established. The foundation stone for the Anglican Cathedral of St Boniface was laid in 1961. The cathedral was consecrated on 14 October 1962 on land originally purchased in 1916.
