

Alexander Library Building

Emergency Evacuation Procedures

The following guidelines are provided In the Interests of public safety

The Alexander Library Building is a modern public building with various types of Fire protection devices designed to alert building occupants to Emergency situations and to assist in controlling these emergencies

Building Wardens may be Identified as those people wearing a **YELLOW OR RED** helmet Please follow their directions to ensure your safe evacuation If necessary

ALERT TONE SOUNDING

The Alert tone is signified by a continuous BEEP, BEEP, BEEP sound. The purpose of this tone is to alert occupants that a possible emergency situation may exist. This tone will be silenced whilst the emergency is investigated. During this time members of the public should remain calm and prepare to evacuate If necessary

EVACUATION TONE SOUNDING

The Evacuation tone is signified by a continuous WHOOP, WHOOP, WHOOP sound. The Purpose of this tone is to alert occupants that an evacuation of the building is required. Members of the public should remain calm and move to the nearest Fire Stair (Muster Point) controlled by a Warden. Please follow the directions of the Warden and exit the building to the Assembly Area as shown in the following plan.
